  2. Candidate will Fill up the Application form, upload the required documents and pay the Fee prescribed **on line**.
  3. Candidate will take print out of the Form and Receipt and submit to Facilitation center declared by Directorate of Higher Education.

7. NRI, OCI, PIO candidate will approach the institutes for admission of their choice before the last date of seeking admission in the third round of admissions..
8. Institute will check the eligibility, documents and give him admissions by generating on line admission letter from their log in.
9. Institute will update online his admission on <http://dhe.mhpravesh.in> Portal.

4. The applicant may, however, be required to present original document for verification, if required.
5. We do not accept scanned document for equivalence.
6. It is the responsibility of students to provide all documents, as desired by AIU.

### **NOTE :**

The candidates intending to join Medical prograqmme, at under graduate level are required to have studied the subjects of Physics, Chemistry, Biology and English, and those intending to join Engineering should have studied Physics, Chemistry, Mathematics and English in Grade 11 and 12

### Percentage Uniform Marks

The majority of students who have taken Cambridge examinations receive a **percentage uniform mark (PUM)** on their **Statement of Results**. The percentage uniform marks correspond to the grades available (A\*, A, B, C etc.) and give students additional information about their performance. They show students whether they are in the middle of a grade, or near either the top or the bottom. The percentage uniform mark is stated at syllabus level only. As its name suggests, the percentage uniform mark is always calculated out of 100.

**The percentage uniform marks should be used by Higher Education Institutions in India for admissions purposes.**

In a small number of countries, Cambridge students are not issued with percentage uniform marks. In such cases, the midpoint of the range should be used by Higher Education Admissions in India for admissions purposes.

The range for percentage uniform marks is as follows:

#### **A Level**

A\* = 90–100

A = 80–89

B = 70–79

C = 60–69

D = 50–59

E = 40–49

#### **AS Level**

a = 80–100

b = 70–79

c = 60–69

d = 50–59

e = 40–49

For example, if a student has achieved the following grades but has not been issued with percentage uniform marks, the calculation would be:

A Level Mathematics	A* =	95
A Level Chemistry	A =	85
A Level Physics	B =	75
AS Level English	B =	75

**Overall mark = 82.5%** (330 divided by 4)
