Implementation of NEP 2020

Somaiya Vidyavihar University (SVU) implemented NEP 2020 to enhance learning and provide diverse opportunities to its students.

- Four Year Under-Graduate and Integrated Programme: Somaiya Vidyavihar University has offered 13 Four Year Under-Graduate programmes and 1 Integrated BS MS Programme from A Y 2023-24.
- **Multidisciplinary/Interdisciplinary:** The university promotes multidisciplinary/interdisciplinary learning in various programs, ensuring a well-rounded education.
- Academic Bank of Credits & Multiple Exit Options: Implemented the Academic Bank of Credits, allowing students flexibility in their academic journey through lateral entry and exit options are available to SVU students.
- **Focus on OBE framework** The university emphasizes the Outcome-Based Education (OBE) framework and conducts workshops and webinars to sensitize faculty members to OBE principles. All the course are aligned with Course & Program outcomes.
- **Study of Indian & Foreign Languages** The Department of Languages and Literature offers programs in both Indian and foreign languages, including Hindi, Marathi, Gujarati, Urdu, Chinese, French, German, Italian, Japanese, and Spanish.





- Semester Exchange Programs with International Universities Somaiya Vidyavihar University has over 8 partnerships with International Universities across 5 countries in the world. Through the development of these partnerships, the institution provides enriching International Semester Exchange opportunities to our undergraduate and postgraduate students as a part of their programme.
- Integration of MOOCs in curriculum Currently B.Sc. Biotechnology Honours And M.Sc. Environmental Studies programme have MOOCs as a part of credit requirement in the curriculum. The university integrates Massive Open Online Courses (MOOCs) into its curriculum, with select programs already incorporating them as credit requirements. MOOCs will become a part of the curriculum for all programs, and integrated courses will be designed accordingly.
- Community Engagement: SVU is actively engaged in community outreach and offers education in Pali, Buddhism, and Yoga at its outreach center near Shirdi, Ahmednagar.
- **Vocational Courses -** University is planning for online mode of offering vocational courses to students from AY 2024-2025.
- **Skill Enhancement:** World class teacher's training programme in Yoga is planned.
- The university also focuses on interfaith values and ethics by offering programs through workshops, seminars, and group discussions that utilize media such as films, art, and literature.
- The University also facilitates faculty and staff to enhance their technical / professional skills by encouraging them to undergo faculty development programmes / skill development programmes / industrial internships.
