Duration of UG	Total Credits for UG	Credit Requirement for Major	Remaining Credits
3-year	120	60	
4-Year	160	80	Students can earn from multiple subject, apprenticeships, skill courses etc.

#### Salient Features of ADP and EDP

- The transcripts should record only the courses the students take in a semester.
- The degree will contain a note stating that the academic requirements required in a standard duration have been completed in a shorted/extended duration.
- Govt. departments, Recruiting agencies, Private organization should treat the Accelerated Degree Programme and Extended Degree Programme on par with degrees with standard duration.
