Notification Regarding Admission For Art, Science & Commerce Courses Under <u>Jammu & Kashmir Migrant Quota.</u>

As per Government of Maharashtra's G.R. dated, 3rd July, 1995, 24th June, 1996 and 28th June 2009 (available on Directorate's website) there is a provision for special educational concession to the wards of displaced citizens and wards of officers and staff of military and paramilitary forces posted to combat terrorists activities in Jammu & Kashmir state which is now Union Territory of Jammu & Kashmir and Union Territory of Ladakh.

Students are advised to apply addressing to **DIRECTOR**, **HIGHER EDUCATION**, **MAHARASHTRA STATE**, **PUNE** on E-mail address mavi.dhepune@nic.in.

Application shall be complete including full name of student, address, contact number, E-mail address, Name of courses & preference college list. Applicants should enclose the necessary documents with self attestation as per Government Resolution dated 3rd July, 1995 Appendix "A". For any query call (020) 26122119. After following due procedure Recommendation letters will be issued on applicant's e-mail address.

Under this scheme, students can take admission in any college under the jurisdiction of the Directorate of Higher Education. (Colleges in Pune, Mumbai and any other cities of Maharashtra, where the course of the student's choice is available) The list of colleges under the jurisdiction of the Directorate of Higher Education is available on the Directorate's website. (Government colleges /Aided colleges / Self-financed colleges)

Students who wish to take admission in Arts, Science and Commerce stream (traditional courses) through the subject scheme after 12th can apply to the Directroate of Higier Education, pune-16. However, the CET exams of engineering, medical, technical and professional courses mentioned in the government decisions are not conducted by the Higher Education Department. Students who wish to take admission in such courses through this scheme shall contact the department where the relevant course is conducted. Such students shall not send their applications to the Directorate of Higher Education office, pune.

The last date to avail this concession for courses under Directorate of Higher Education is 30th June, 2025 for academic year 2025-26.



INTRODUCTION: Normal civic life and public order have been seriously affected dug to terrorist activities in the State of Jammu & Kashmir. Quite a large number of people in the State have been displaced and have sought shalter with their relatives in other parts of the country or in the cohold Il fallow compa. The social and aconomic life of these people has been considerably disrupted with the result that their children have been considerably handicapped in the relation. Similarly, quite a large number of officers and such of the military and para-military forces have been deployed in the State to combat terrorists' autivities. These officers and staff have to discharge onerous duties against heavy adds. Children of such officers and staff and also all officers belonging to Indian Administration Service and Indian Polica Service posted in Jammu and Kashmir have been facing difficulties in continuing their education. fortunately, adequate facilities are available in Maharashtra in the field of engineering, pharmacy, architecture, arts, science, commerce, education ste. The question of extending assistance to the above categories of students has been under the consideration of this Government for sometime past.

RESOLUTION

2. Government is now pleased to direct that the facilities for Higher Education in the field of engineering, phermacy, architectura, both at degree and diploma level as also Arts, Science, Commerce Education and Law will be provided to children of citizens displaced due to terrorists' activities. From Jammu & Kashmir as also children of officers belonging to Indian Administration Service, Indian Police Service and other officers and staff belonging to military and para-military forces transferred to Jammu & Kashmir to deal with terrorists' activities.

In order to be eligible for admission to these courses, the students aught to fulfil the prescribed minimum educational qualifications laid down by the State Government and/or Universities: So far as the admission to Diploma/Degree Courses in Engineering, Pharmacy, Architecture atc. the candidates should have secured at least 50% marks in Physics, Chemistry, Maths taken together at one and the same seating (45% marks in the subject of physics, chemistry, maths, taken together at one and same seating for B.C. candidates. Admission to other courses of digher Education will be effected on the basis of the condition regarding minimum educational qualifications prescribed by the respective Universities in the State.

In order to accommodate the aligible students for admission to different courses in the field of Higher and Technical Education, one seat per course over and above the sanctioned intake capacity is heraby permitted to be created in every Government, Aided and Non-Aided Diploma/Degrae level institutions. These seats cannot be allotted to any students other than those mentioned The annilcations for admission should be addressed on plain paper to Secretary Higher & Technical Education Department (Kashmir Coll); 4th Floor, Mantralaya, Bombay-400 032 and submitted by post on or before 15th July 1995 at the latest. Applicant may indicates nhoice of college/courses and the allotment shall be strictly on merit-cum-preference basis.
