
I am directed to state that the Scholarship amount [consisting of Admission and Tution fee (if any) and Maintenance Allowance] as per the rates stipulated under the Scheme guidelines of Post-Matric Scholarship and Merit-cum Means based Scholarship Schemes for students belonging to minority communities, will be transferred to students' bank account through Public Financial Management System (PFMS) following the Direct Benefit Transfer (DBT) mode from 2014-15.

2. From the Financial Year 2013-14 it has been made mandatory for students belonging to minority communities to apply for Post-Matric Scholarship and Merit-cum Means based Scholarship Schemes online in the dedicated web portal of this Ministry i.e. www.momascholarship.gov.in.

Activity Timelines and Community-wise Physical Targets for the year 2014-15, under these Scholarship Schemes have already been communicated to all States/UTs (the same is also uploaded in the website of this Ministry i.e. www.minorityaffairs.gov.in). No offline applications for Scholarship under Post-matric Scholarship and Merit-cum Means based Scholarship Scheme will be entertained during the year 2014-15.
