Subject: Guidelines for Operationalization of National Scholarship Portal 2.0 (NSP 2.0).

Sir,

In continuation of this Ministry's letter of even number dated 20<sup>th</sup> July, 2016 on the subject mentioned above, I am directed to draw your attention to *Para - 3(h)* of the guidelines of the Cabinet Secretariat letter No, I-11011/150/2015-DBT dated 15<sup>th</sup> July, 2016 addressed to All Chief Secretaries/Administrator, State/Union Territories. The Para in question, is reproduced as under:

"Supporting documents of scholarships amount less than Rs. 50,000/- be kept at institution level and for scholarships amount more than Rs. 50,000/- may be uploaded on the portal".

2. All State Governments/UT Administrations are requested to advice the School/College/Institution etc., that the supporting documents for Scholarships amount less than Rs. 50,000/- are to be kept at their level and for Scholarships amount more than Rs. 50,000/- may be uploaded on National Scholarship Portal 2.0 (NSP 2.0).
